

Accessing and Using the Online Conference Platform

Below are instructions for the “on-demand” format of the Conference, using the online Conference platform.

This platform has identical content to the Live format of Conference, with all pre-recorded Conference presentations available for unlimited viewing, at any time, from Oct. 20 to Dec. 19, 2022 (all times are Eastern Time zone of USA (ET)).

Note: Discussions from the Live Conference’s Question and Answer (Q&A) sessions (Nov 2-5), Poster sessions (Nov 4 & 5), and 6 simultaneous Workshops (Nov 5) will be recorded and made available in the online Conference platform in the week after the Live Conference; these will remain available until Dec. 19, 2022.


Conference Platform

The online Conference platform contains all required materials for both the On-demand **and** Live formats of the Conference.

To gain access to the Live Conference (delivered via Zoom Webinar), you must access the online platform (i.e., the registration process for Zoom webinar, for the Live Conference, is only available via the online platform). Hence, we recommend that you log into the online Platform immediately to confirm that you have no technical problems and to get Zoom webinar links for the Live Conference.

All oral abstract presentations have been pre-recorded and are available on the online platform. These oral presentations have live Q&A sessions, as indicated in the Conference brochure, that will be recorded and posted to the online platform.

Shortly after Nov. 5, 2022, you will receive a reminder email to complete your Conference evaluation. **This evaluation is required to obtain your Continuing Education (CE/CME) Certificate.** After Nov. 5, click this link and follow the instructions to complete the Cloud CME evaluation and obtain your certificate:

The deadline to receive ASHA credit is Nov. 19 (you must complete the Evaluation by Nov. 19, 2022). No exceptions are permitted by ASHA.

For all others seeking credit other than ASHA, the evaluation and attestation will expire on Dec. 19, 2022, after which we are unable to process your certificate.

3. Sign-In using your email address and password (or JHED ID and password if you are from Johns Hopkins)
4. Click on **My CME**
5. Click on **Evaluations and Certificates**
6. Click "Complete Evaluation" in the row for **Eleventh Annual Johns Hopkins Critical Care Rehab. Conference**

For Physical Therapists only: On the evaluation and credits screen, when selecting a certificate for download, please select any PT state board that is listed. All of the PT approval statements are listed on each certificate.

Once submitted, you will be directed to a brief survey to offer your Conference feedback.

After the above, your certificate will be immediately available for print or download.
